

# Schultz House Archaeology Project

## Volunteer Registration and Schedule

Archaeological field work will be conducted at the Schultz House property from August 31 through September 24, 2009. Excavation will be undertaken four days a week. Morning sessions begin at 9am and run through Noon. Afternoon sessions begin at 12:45pm and run through 4:15pm. Tools will be provided. Bring drinking water; a lunch (if working both morning and afternoon sessions); work gloves (optional); sun tan lotion (optional); insect repellent (optional); kneeling pad (optional); and a hat (optional).

Artifact processing (cleaning and labeling objects found during field work) will be done in a barn on the Schultz House property. Processing will begin on October 5 and conclude on October 15, 2009. Morning and afternoon sessions will have the same hours as field work sessions noted above. Again, tools will be provided. Bring drinking water and a lunch if working morning and afternoon sessions. The field component of the Schultz House archaeology project involves strenuous physical activity in the sun. Participants must be prepared to spend several hours on their knees and have the ability to lift and carry buckets of soil which can weigh up to 25 pounds. Furthermore, excavators will sift soil in shaker screens, requiring the vigorous use of shoulder joints. The laboratory component of the project requires the ability to carefully clean and label small objects. The work is not physically taxing but does require the ability to see clearly, patience, and legible handwriting.

Ten volunteer positions are available for each morning and afternoon session. Volunteers will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. **Volunteers must be 16 years of age or older.** To register please complete the [Volunteer Registration Form](#), sign the [Liability Waiver](#), and list your session preferences [9-Noon and/or 12:45-4:15] in the white blocks on the appropriate [calendar](#) pages below.
